- Make sure you are safely looked after
- Make sure you have the best life chances and can grow up happy and successful

How we will protect you:

- We build relationships with the important adults in your life
- We help to ensure that you remain safe at home and sometimes work with other agencies to support this
- We think it is important for you to know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something
